

ACT TESTING

Students take the ACT college readiness test for multiple reasons, such as trying to get scholarships (including Bright Futures), trying to meet college admissions criteria, and trying to earn a high enough score on the reading section in order to meet graduation requirements in case they did not pass the state FSA reading test. The next ACT test administration date is Saturday, October 28. The test is given at Bayside High, but students must have registered for the test by the deadline of September 22. Students can register at www.actstudent.org and must be able to upload a head shot picture of themselves and print out their admissions ticket. Students in grades 11 and 12 who are on free or reduced lunch or who are in the foster care system can qualify for a fee waiver (a maximum of 2 per their high school career) which allows them to take the test with or without the writing subtest for free and allows them free access to the ACT Kaplan Online Prep live (test prep) program. Students must see their school counselor to obtain the fee waiver prior to the registration deadline. Also, students who have an IEP, 504, or who are active in an ESOL program may be eligible for certain testing accommodations. These students must indicate during the registration process that they are requesting accommodations, and then an ACT employee will contact Ms. Barbuto (Bayside counselor) to verify eligibility and complete the request process. Approval is not 100% guaranteed. For questions, please contact your student's counselor.

The next ACT will be administered at Bayside High on Saturday, December 9, 2017. For juniors and seniors who are trying to meet college admissions requirements, scholarship requirements, and high school graduation requirements, be sure to register by November 3. Students who are on free and reduced lunch and students who are in foster care can see their high school counselors about possibly taking the test for free.

 There is a BPS OverDrive icon on your Launchpad (if you don't see it, simply add it with your plus symbol).


Select Bayside High School from the dropdown, and then type in your student (or faculty/staff) ID in the box and click Sign In.




