Science Bowl: Beyer had 2 teams competing in this year's Regional Science Bowl competition. There were 24 total teams representing 16 high schools from as far north as Lodi (Tokay) and as far south as Fresno (Clovis). The first part of the competition is 5 rounds in the morning. Beyer Red went undefeated (won 5 of 5) and Beyer White won 3 of 5. The 2 teams that Beyer White lost to in the morning were the 2nd & 3rd place winners, so they faced some tough competition. Beyer Red went on to the afternoon double elimination rounds as one of the top 8 teams. They were eliminated after 3 nail-biting rounds and secured a 4th place finish. Tokay and Clovis teams won top 3 spots with Clovis being the top contender and winning an all-expenses paid trip to the National competition in Washington D.C. in April.

Work Permits Information & Summer Employment:

All minors under age 18 (unless a high school graduate or equivalent), including minors employed by parents must have a work permit. During summer months, applications are available at the District's School-to-Career Office. Please call 209-492-5128, if you need a summer permit. The office locations will be moving soon to Locust Ave.

All Work Permits expire five (5) days after school starts and must be re-issued at the start of each school year or at the time the student obtains a new job. Work Permits are required all year, not just when school is in session. It serves as an age certificate and states the maximum hours a minor may work based on their age (Ed. C. 49160). 




