It has been a great 2017/2018 school year and our students continue to accomplish tremendous feats. Our Women's Chorale, Concert Choir, and Chamber Choir all received Command Performances at the Clovis Unified School District Choir Festival. This is the highest rating a choir can receive in CUSD. The Buchanan History Day Teams dominated the Fresno County Regionals. Twelve students took home 1st place honors and qualified for the State Championships. Our Destination Imagination Team had ten students take home first place at the San Joaquin Valley Regional and qualified for the State Championships. In athletics our Girls Soccer team won the Valley Championship for the 10th time in the past thirteen years. Wrestling took home their third consecutive TRAC, Valley and State Championships.

Facts of Lice

Head lice are tiny wingless insects that live in a person's hair and feed on small amounts of blood drawn from the scalp. Lice do not spread disease and they do not fly or jump. Lice eggs are called nits and they appear as tiny oval specks of grey or yellow that attach to the hair shaft. Unlike dandruff, nits do not easily flake off the hair.

Signs & Symptoms:

- Severe itching & scratching of the scalp.
- Nits on the hair shaft, usually on the back of the head between the ears.
- Louse/lice (tiny, grayish-brown insect).
- Red bumps on the scalp from irritation.

What to do if your child has Lice:

- Check with your doctor or pharmacist for a recommended treatment.
- Check everyone in the home for lice and treat if needed.
- Wash all clothes and bed linens in hot water and run through a hot dryer.
- Vacuum all carpet and cloth-covered furniture in your home and car.
- Replace hair care items such as brushes, combs, hair ties, etc.
- Seal all non-washable items such as stuffed animals in a plastic garbage bag for two weeks.

Think Prevention:

- Try to avoid head to head contact with other people.
- Do not share combs, brushes, hair ties, hats, scarves, pillows, etc.
