### November CCS Mental Health Monthly Theme: *Gratitude* WHY IS GRATITUDE IMPORTANT?

Research consistently and strongly supports the association between gratitude and greater happiness. Gratitude has been linked with good experiences, improved health, positive emotions, and the ability to build strong relationships.

Dr. Martin E.P. Seligman tested the impact of writing and delivering a letter of gratitude on the writer and discovered this action provided immediate improvements in mood and demonstrated benefits lasting for at least a month. Another study by Dr. Robert A. Emmons and Dr, Michael E McCullough found that individuals who wrote consistently about what they are grateful for, demonstrated improved optimism and had fewer visits to their physician for areas of concern.

Therefore, the consistent and intentional practice of gratitude can provide long term social, emotional, and physical benefits.




#### **BOOK RENTAL**


