Are you interested in joining the National Honor Society? Here are the steps and requirements that a student must complete to obtain membership:

1. The student attends the informational meeting scheduled for April 2nd in the auditorium either 8:30am before school OR at 3:45pm right after school (no you don't attend both meetings, just one). If a student is absent from school that day, they should see the chapter advisor in room 730 immediately upon their return to school to see about

obtaining an application.

- Student turns in an application for membership by the due date. The application is the way in which a student proves the requirements (see below). The application will be available at the meeting scheduled for April 2nd.
- Student will be a junior or senior NEXT school year.
- Weighted CUMALATIVE GPA of at least 3.75.
- At least 40 volunteer hours turned into the school's guidance office by the time the application is due.
- Sign-off from Dean's office verifying no major school infractions on record.


