Academy Students Help Cleanup in Irma's Aftermath

Students in the Environmental Sciences Academy recently volunteered with the Guana Estuarine Research Reserve in a marine debris study and coastal cleanup. Their efforts were part of a service project to help with debris cleanup along the coastline from Hurricane Irma's impacts last month. In addition to debris removal, students participated in citizen science by collecting data on various types of marine debris. They submitted their findings to the International Coastal Cleanup Project with The Ocean Conservancy, in an effort to better understand marine debris impacts in St. Johns County and on a global scale. Creekside students have participated in the annual International Coastal Cleanup for the past decade, each year since Creekside opened. This year, students collected over 250 pounds of trash per hour! They are eager to soon help in other area beaches; as cleanup efforts are still needed along the coastline throughout St. Johns County.

18th birthday. The cause of the accident was excessive speed by her sister's boyfriend. She gave the students advice to use to get themselves out of a potentially dangerous situation.
