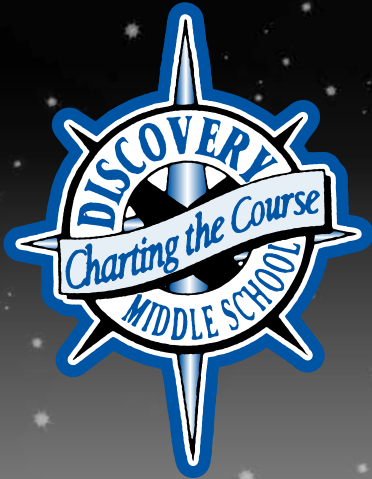

KEYSTONE SCIENCE INSTITUTE

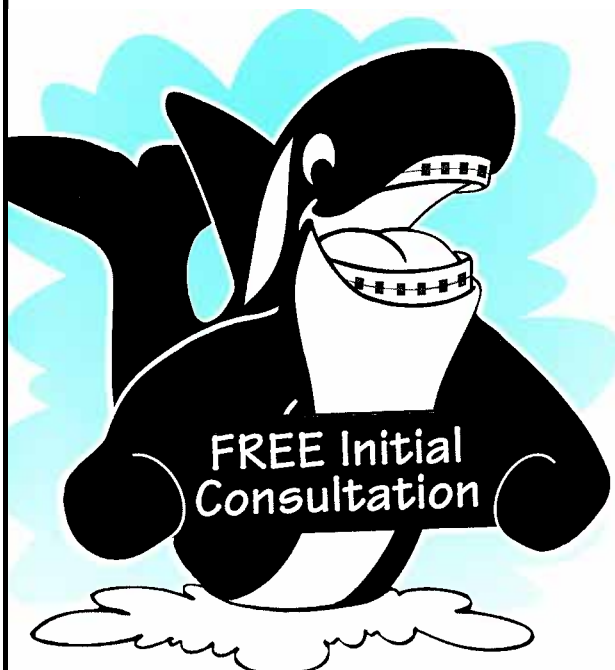

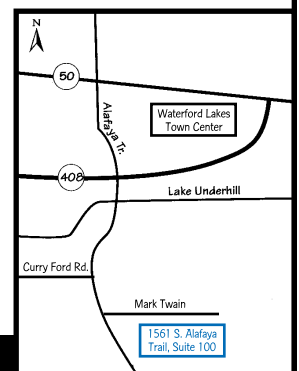
