TUTORING EVERY TUESDAY

The After School Tutoring program is off to a great start with over 240 students signed up. The program is held every Tuesday from 2:30pm to 4:30pm in the Media Center. We have open enrollment year round and provide tutoring in Math, English, Reading, Science, Social Studies, AP Spanish, and ACT/SAT Prep.

We have a certified teacher in each core subject area tutoring in our program to assists students who mainly come for homework help. Additionally, National Honor Society students receive hours when they volunteer in peer tutoring. Students are allowed to check-in and attend an after school session held by their teacher and return to the program with a pass. Also, we are working on providing additional tutoring resources to our students through the Orange County Public Library.

Transportation is provided to students based on a signed permission form and takes about 2 weeks to become effective. Students can get a tutoring signup form from the main office in room 120. For any further questions regarding tutoring, please contact Mrs.Banuche at Christina.Banuche@ocps.net.

DID YOU KNOW?

East River provides supper each afternoon from 2:15-2:30pm in the Cafeteria. This program is free and students staying after school to participate in tutoring, club activities, performing arts groups, and sports teams are eligible. Students sign in, get their food, and then can move on to the next event in their busy day!

The khanacademy.org website provides FREE practice opportunities for the SAT? English teachers have helped students connect their Khan Academy account to their College Board accounts so that their results from the October PSAT or SAT are visible. When the two accounts are linked, the Khan Academy program provides specific areas that students need additional practice so they can raise their SAT scores. This means that parents do not have to spend money for expensive test preparation as students take these college entrance exams.

Attendance is important! When students do not attend school regularly they miss out on the instruction that helps them meet the state requirements for graduation. Did you also know that students between 14 and 17 years of age are reported to the DMV when they accumulate 15 unexcused absences in a 90 day calendar period? This can lead to the suspension of their driver's license.

Are you aware that if your student has an Orange County Library system card, live tutors are available for all subject areas from 2-11pm on the internet and can provide support in both English and Spanish? Applications for the Orange County Library Card are available in the Media Center.






MANAGE ALERTS IN PARENT ACCESS

for your ProgressBook ParentAccess Web site account displays in the first Email address field.





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


