Finally, we are so excited to announce Tatum Proffitt, an FHS Senior, has scored a perfect 36 composite score—the highest possible—on the ACT. 


#### **BUTLER TECH**

The 2nd conference night of the school year will be held on Thursday 12/02/21. Conferences run in 15-minute increments and are scheduled with each teacher individually. Parent/Guardian sign-ups will start on Tuesday 11/02/21 and end on Sunday 11/28/21. - 2. When prompted to pick a conference (teacher name) you only need to pick 1 teacher, then hit submit. Please double check that you are choosing the correct type of conference before scheduling.

- You will then register your student and enter an email address. After this information is submitted, an email will be sent to you confirming your registration along with a link to set appointment times and/or to schedule another student.

PLEASE REMEMBER: You must 1st register online and then the link to schedule conferences and pick a time. A conference is not considered "scheduled" until a time has been selected. You will receive an email with all conferences and times that have been scheduled. If you DO NOT receive a confirmation email, then your conferences have NOT been scheduled.
