MHS Student Honored

Student Visionaries is a seven-week fundraising challenge where high school student leaders raise money and awareness for the fight against blood cancers. This year's campaign kicked off on January 12th and culminated at our Grand Finale Gala, on March 1. Izzy and her team raised an incredible \$3,579 for the cure. During her campaign, Izzy and her team came together as a community to raise these funds.

State Testing: Begins April 17th

The following courses are required to take the end of course exam: Algebra I, Geometry, ELA II, Biology, American History, and Government. Students who have taken these courses this school year as well as those needing retakes for Algebra I and ELA II should plan to be in attendance for these tests. All Exams begin at 7:40am. Those students who are not taking the test will have a delayed start that day but will need their own transportation. Students who must ride the bus will arrive at the normal time and have a study hall in the cafeteria on these testing days. **STUDENTS WHO ARE LATE TO SCHOOL DUE TO LATE DROP-OFFS MAY BE DENIED ADMISSION FOR TESTING ON THAT DATE. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT ALL TESTING STUDENTS ARRIVE ON TIME. Graduation 2024

SAVE THE DATE!!!! **The date for the 2024 MHS Graduation is SUNDAY, MAY 19th at 2pm at the Stranahan.** In order to participate in the ceremony, seniors need to:

1. meet all local and state graduation requirements prior to the ceremony date
2. attend **graduation practice (Thursday, May 16th @ 9 am in the Stranahan Theater)**
*****Any Senior who fails to attend Graduation Practice will not walk at Graduation**
3. not be serving any consequence for discipline over graduation weekend
4. paid all outstanding school fees and fines prior to the ceremony date.
*****Seniors will be required to return to school after Graduation Practice.**

Dress for Graduation:

Maumee High School Graduation is a formal event.

- **Ladies:** Avoid dark colors or patterned dresses under the white graduation gown as these will be visible through the gown. No tennis shoes, flip flops, excessively high heels, or boots are permitted. If the student wears unacceptable footwear, they will not be permitted to sit on the stage or cross the stage for the ceremony. Replacement shoes must be provided prior to the start of the ceremony or the student will not participate.
- **Gentlemen:** Wear a button-down shirt and a tie. Brown or black slacks. Brown or black dress shoes. No jeans, tennis shoes, flip flops, sandals, or boots are permitted. If the student wears unacceptable footwear, they will not be permitted to sit on the stage or cross the stage for the ceremony. Replacement shoes must be provided prior to the start of the ceremony or the student will not participate.

Caps & Tassels:

No alterations or additions to the standard issued caps & tassels will be permitted. No writing on the caps.

Medallions, Cords, Stoles at the Graduation Ceremony

Maumee High School ONLY PERMITS THE USE OF SCHOOL ISSUED MEDALLIONS, CORDS, or STOLES at the graduation ceremony. No other adornments will be permitted at the graduation ceremony. Caps are not to be decorated.

Medallions at the Maumee High School Graduation Ceremony are reserved for those students who have earned an Ohio Honors Diploma. Freshman, Sophomores, and Juniors who want to be recognized with this distinction at their graduation ceremony should ask their school counselor if they are on track to earn an Ohio Honors Diploma. Counselors can make sure that they are registered for the appropriate courses to be eligible.

Cords at the Maumee High School Graduation Ceremony are reserved for those students who are active members of the National Honor Society (gold) or the National Technical Honor Society (purple).

Stoles at the Maumee High School Graduation Ceremony are reserved for those students who have earned a National Merit distinction as a national merit finalist, semifinalist, or commended scholar.

GRADUATION ACADEMIC RECOGNITION

Graduating students at Maumee High School receive individual academic recognition at the graduation ceremony based on the Latin Honors System and the earning of a State of Ohio Honors Diploma. Every student who earns an honors diploma will receive an academic medallion at the graduation ceremony and will be recognized by name for that award. The earning of an honors diploma is NOT based on taking any honors courses, it is simply the culmination of 4 years of a prescribed college preparatory curriculum. To earn a state of Ohio academic honors diploma, the student must complete any 7 of the following 8 criteria:

1. 4 credits of English
2. 4 credits of Math including Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2, and a higher level math
3. 4 credits of Science including 2 credits of Advanced Science
4. 4 credits of Social Studies
5. 3 credits of the same Foreign Language or 2 credits in two different languages
6. 1 credit of Fine Arts
7. 3.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale
8. 27 Composite on the ACT

General Information

Scheduling for 2024-2025

The counseling department has met with every student in grades 8-11 to plan the appropriate set of course selections for next school year. In mid-to late-May, the students will receive a tentative schedule for the 2024-2025 school year. Course selection decisions are made using a variety of data: courses needed to graduate, courses needed for the student's post-secondary path (college ready, career ready, military ready), courses to prepare for state and national assessments, and courses based on student interest. One of our goals is to move every student forward with the ultimate goal of a State of Ohio Honors Diploma (see next section).

After-School Tutoring

MHS offers supervised after-school tutoring and quiet study opportunities every day from 2:30 - 3:30 pm. Transportation home is provided at 3:45 pm for students who are eligible to ride the bus (live more than 1 mile from the building). At 3:30 pm, students who require a bus to take them home will be given a transportation ticket from the Supervising Teacher and can take that ticket to Maumee Intermediate School (formerly Wayne Trail) to catch a bus.

Student Assessments and Academic Intervention Services
