Greeting Parents,



Cell Phone Policy for Students

A student may possess a cell phone on school property, at after school activities, and at school-related functions, provided that during school hours and on a school bus, the cell phone remains off and is concealed. Parents can login to Canvas using the credentials below. Parents have one username/password for each student.

Username: The letter "G" then the student ID number

Password: The letter "G" then the student date of birth (YYYYMMDD)




Tutoring

Fall Beautification Day


