CLASS OF 2016 – COMMUNITY SERVICE REQUIRE-MENT: Seniors graduating in May of 2016 must have 20 hours of community service as a graduation requirement. The 20 hours must be recorded in the senior's transcript prior to Friday, May 6. Community Service Volunteer Log Forms are available in the Guidance Office and on the guid-

ance Edline page.

SAT & ACTTESTING: Sign up for the SAT and ACT online. Reminder: The new redesigned SAT will begin in March, 2016. Please visit the College Board website for details. The websites are: www.sat.collegeboard.org and www. actstudent.org. All juniors will be given the SAT free of charge during the school day on Wednesday, March 2. Colleges are now requesting that students do their testing in the second semester of their junior year in order to meet the early deadlines in the fall of the student's senior year.

COLLEGE ADMISSIONS AND APPLICATIONS: Congratulations to seniors already accepted at colleges and universities. Seniors are reminded to submit transcript requests and recommendation letter requests to their school counselor at least two weeks prior to the deadline set by the college.

SCHOLARSHIP BULLETIN: Seniors are encouraged to check the Scholarship Bulletin posted on the guidance Edline page, which is updated with new scholarships periodically.

BRIGHT FUTURES SCHOLARSHIPS: Any senior seeking to acquire any of the Bright Futures Scholarships must fill out the state financial aid form at https://www.floridastudentfinancialaidsg.org/ua/sawstua_uaform.asp. If this form is not submitted, the student will not receive the scholarship money.

FINANCIAL AID FOR COLLEGE: Parents and students planning on applying for financial aid must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Online FAFSA forms are available at www.fafsa.ed.gov.

JUNIOR PARENT NIGHT: On Tuesday evening, April 5 the school counseling department will be hosting Junior Parent Night from 6:00 to 7:30 in our auditorium. Parents and students are invited to learn about graduation requirements, financial aid and the college application process. You will also be attending a college fair to meet with local university, college, career, and military contacts in our school cafeteria.

WWW.FLORIDASHINES.ORG: Parents and students are encouraged to visit the state website Floridashines.org for detailed information on career, college and vocational school planning, plus links to many additional educational and student-service programs. A feature of this website allows students to view their high school Bright Futures transcript.

EDLINE: Please make sure you have access to your child's Edline account. Edline allows you to keep up with upcoming news and events, current grades, upcoming assignments, etc. Stay involved!!

CREDIT LAB: Students in need of credit recovery may enroll in our credit lab which is open after school every Tuesday through Thursday afternoon from 3:00 to 5:00 in room 6-208. For further information, please see your school counselor.



From the desk of your Health Care District School Nurse

Your smile is one of the first things people notice about you. It is important to take care of it right from the start. The American Dental Association (ADA) recommends that children visit the dentist within six months of their first tooth and before their first birthday for a "Well Baby Check Up." February is Dental Health Month.

Recommendations for good dental health include:

- Brushing your teeth for two minutes, twice a day with fluoride toothpaste
- Flossing daily
- Avoiding sugary and starchy snacks
- Wearing a mouth guard when you're active
- Not smoking
- Not piercing your lips or any part of your mouth
- Getting dental sealants
- Considering a fluoride program if your water is not fluoridated
- Visiting your dentist regularly for check-ups and cleaning


