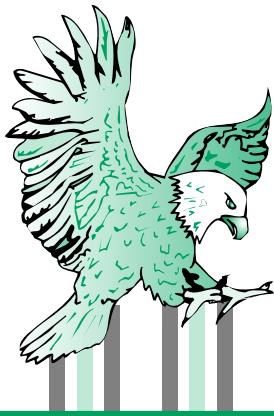

School Hours

Our school day starts promptly at 7:30am and ends at 2:45pm. We will continue to follow our modified block schedule. This schedule alternates odd and even periods with the first period meeting every day. On odd days periods 1,3,5, and 7 will meet and on even days periods 2,4, 5, and 6 will meet. What Your Child Needs For 2021–2022 School Entry

Before entering or attending school in-person or virtually (kindergarten through twelfth grade) each child must provide a *Florida Certification of Immunization* (DH 680 form), documenting the following vaccinations:

Public/Private Schools Kindergarten through Twelfth Grade:

- Four or five doses of diphtheria-tetanus-pertussis (DTaP) vaccine*
- Three doses of hepatitis B (Hep B) vaccine
- Three, four or five doses of polio (IPV) vaccine*
- Two doses of measles-mumps-rubella (MMR) vaccine
- Two doses of varicella vaccine†

Seventh Grade:

In addition to kindergarten through twelfth grade vaccines, students entering or attending seventh grade need the following vaccinations:

- One dose of tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis (Tdap) vaccine in grades seven through twelve
- An updated DH 680 form to include Tdap, must be obtained for submission to the school

[‡] The fifth dose of DTaP vaccine is not necessary if the fourth dose was administered at age 4 years or older.
^{*} If four or more doses are administered before age 4 years, an additional dose should be administered at age 4 through 6 years and at least six months after the previous dose. A fourth dose is not necessary if the third dose was administered at age 4 years or older and at least six months after the previous dose.
[†] Varicella vaccine is not required if varicella disease is documented by the health care provider.

VAPING EPIDEMIC

Tobacco use has made a resurgence back into the hands of youth with e-cigarettes. They are also commonly referred to as “e-ciggs”, “Juuling” and “Vaping”. These products are marketed towards teens with social media advertisements and fruity flavors. The CDC noted that from 2017 to 2018 there was a 78% increase in the number of high-schoolers who reported using e-cigarettes.

Some teens are unaware that these products contain nicotine. Nicotine affects every organ in the human body including the teenager’s developing brain. E-cigarettes are not safe for children or youth and the long-term effects have yet to be studied. Parent Guide for Medications at School

The following is required before any medication can be taken by or administered to a child on school grounds:

1



A new **Authorization for Medication / Treatment Form** is required each school year and for any changes to the current order during the school year.



The form (available in the physician's office) must be completed by the **prescribing physician** for all medication.

The form must also have the **parent signature** completed in order for medication to be administered.



2



Prescribed and Over-the-Counter Medications:



Prescribed medications must be in the **original container with a pharmacy label, not expired and matching the current physician's order**. When filling your prescription, request the pharmacy labels' expiration date state. **"See Manufacturer's Medication Expiration Date."**

Over-the-counter medications must also be in the **original unopened container, not expired and labeled with the child's name**.



Medication must be **delivered to the school by an adult**, not your child. A medication count and co-signature for the delivery and receipt of the medication will be required.

A **current photo** of the child is required for identification purposes and will be attached to the medication record. **The photo should be delivered with the physician's order and medication.**
