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


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

Parking permits will be sold in May for all underclassmen who currently have a vehicle to register and a valid drivers' license. Parking permits are \$25 and students will need to have all other accounts settled at the school before being able to purchase parking permits. Parking permits are sold by grade level on a first come, first serve basis. We will announce the dates for Spring parking sales on Facebook and Twitter as well as at the school. We will also have days in the fall before school opens that we will sell permits by grade level before selling them the first week of school. Please contact Mr. Dawes if you have any questions.

This time of year we have a lot of parents call their students out after exams.
