Principal's Message

Dear Boone Families and Friends,

I am thrilled that we are back in business and that it has been another great start to the year. Though things look different right now, I want to thank every member of the Brave community for continuing to distinguish Boone High School as a place where there is a high standard of academic excellence and where our strong school pride fuels a collective purpose. Because of your commitment to ensuring our students' safety, social, and academic needs are met, we have fully embraced and successfully navigated the new LaunchEd/Face to Face hybrid model of instruction. We have one of the highest numbers of students and faculty back on campus and I think this serves as a testament to the notion that Boone High School is a place where people want to be. It is because of your continued support of our school and our students that we have established Boone High School as a place where all members of our community can feel safe, seen, heard, and valued.

The safety of our students has always been our top priority and we have further increased our safety measures under the CDC guidelines. The number of students per classroom is reduced, masks are mandatorily worn by all who enter the campus, gallon jugs of hand sanitizer can be found in every room, and our custodial staff has increased sanitization efforts frequently throughout the day. Please make sure you check in at the Front Office whenever you are on campus. If you, or anyone, need a mask, we will be happy to provide one. Please continue to follow the protocols for student drop-off/pick-up and only use the designated areas for doing so. Stopping on Mills, Wadeview Park, the bus loop, or the faculty parking lot is strictly prohibited.

Though restrictions are in place, our student life is still thriving. We have successfully raised \$3,300 to help our Brave families in need through Kiss the Pig; have celebrated our senior football, girls volleyball, swim, cheerleading, and cross-country teams; and kicked off meetings for our 33 student clubs and organizations. I cannot wait to see what the rest of the year has in store for our students.

Resilience is, and always has been, a core characteristic of our community, and I am so impressed with how all of our students, staff, and families have handled this pandemic. Thank you for your willingness to adapt and adjust to any sudden changes. With new information coming frequently, it is imperative that you take advantage of the various forms of communication our school has to offer. The Smoke Signals newsletter is mailed home four times a year and always contains useful information. 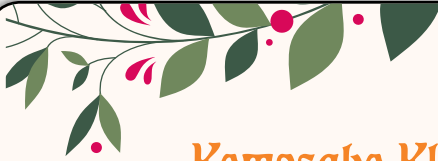

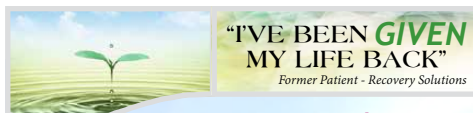

Seniors

Counselors met with all seniors during their English class in the 1st 9 weeks to complete their Post- Secondary Graduation Plans. We invite any seniors who are currently full-time dual-enrolled to set up a meeting with their counselor if they haven’t already done so. We encourage our parent and/or guardians to follow-up with their seniors about their visits with their counselor. Seniors were mailed a transcript, given a graduation checklist and a NEXT magazine. Students were also directed to the BHS guidance canvas page for other necessary senior resources. Resources include: brag sheet to help each counselor writing a personal letter of recommendation, guidance directory and a braves help sheet.

Bright Futures Scholarships

Your student began the student portion of their free application for student aid (FAFSA) in their English class on October 6th .Please follow-up with your student to complete the parent and/or guardian portion of this application. ACT and SAT

Many colleges waived testing requirements this year for admission purposes and some have indicated they will be test optional again next year. However, at the time of publication of this newsletter Florida’s state university system and Florida Bright Futures still require test scores for admission and qualification for scholarships. Juniors and seniors are encouraged to sign up for ACT and SAT tests to reach their goals. If you are eligible for free/reduced lunch, then you are eligible for a fee waiver from The College Board or ACT to take these tests. Students are encouraged to use the free tutorials provided by CollegeBoard.org, ACT.org and Khan Academy online www.khanacademy.org to prepare for tests.

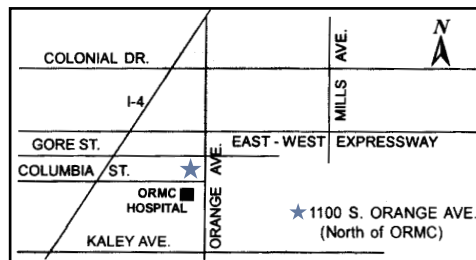

Parents or guardians must create an account for their child and complete all the steps and upload a digital image of the FHSAA EL2 physical form. All accounts must be completed in full, 48 hours before the first day. Your child will be ineligible to participate if this is not completed in time. All athletes must have an account, even if the physical submitted last school year is still valid. If that is the case, the date of the physical will be transferred into their account once it is created.
