Students who receive Special Education services or who have a Section 504 Plan may be eligible to take the PSAT, ACT, SAT, SAT Subject, or AP exams with extended time or other necessary accommodations that are utilized during school. Arrangements for accommodations and special testing must be made through the Counseling Center at least one week before the registration deadline for any given exam. The approval process can take up to 7 weeks, so planning ahead is imperative. Students who previously registered and were approved for accommodations on the PSAT, SAT, or AP are approved for the 2020-2021 school year. Students applying to take the ACT with accommodations must seek approval for every test administration.
