
PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

For the parents, students, staff, and community of Clay Middle School


- We have learned that "heroes" are everyday people doing extraordinary things.

AVID RECRUITMENT TIMELINE APPROACHING

AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) is a college preparatory program which provides increased rigor in a collaborative and supportive atmosphere. The AVID program at Clay Middle is a year-long elective offered for students entering 7th and 8th grades. AVID teaches students who already have the potential for success the skills necessary to excel in middle school and beyond.

If your child meets a few of the following characteristics, consider AVID:

- Achieves high marks on standardized tests such as ILEARN
- Works well in a collaborative environment
- Self-motivation; has the desire for advanced coursework
- Could benefit from additional study skills
 and organization
- Desire for development of leadership skills and increased confidence

The benefits of AVID extend into every classroom. Students learn:

- How to overcome points of confusion
- How to build an understanding for higher order questioning
- Strategies for critical reading and writing
- Public speaking skills
- Self-advocating skills in school
- What it takes to be prepared for college

Clay Middle School proudly announces that 6th, 7th, & 8th grade students at Clay have again swept the City of Carmel's Veterans essay contest!


