



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FROM THE CAFETERIA

First of all, a big WELCOME BACK from the Cafeteria Staff here at Clay!

As I'm sure you're all aware the Free Meal Waiver has been discontinued so parents/guardians have to get back in the habit of paying for student lunches after a 2-year hiatus. A <u>complete</u> school lunch is \$2.80. A <u>complete</u> school lunch includes one entrée, one milk, one fruit and 1 or 2 vegetables. Your student does not have to take all of those components, but they must have an entrée along with one fruit or one vegetable choice for their lunch to be considered complete. If a student does not choose a fruit or vegetable all items chosen will be charged a la carte pricing.

You can check your students lunch account balance any time using EZSchoolPay.com. All you need is their student ID number. WE DO ENCOURAGE EVERYONE TO DEPOSIT FUNDS INTO LUNCH ACCOUNTS THROUGH EZSCHOOLPAY.COM! We are definitely trying to eliminate cash purchases

and deposits as much as possible in an effort to avoid handling cash. If your student has their own money that they would like to use to make a purchase, please have them give that cash to you to deposit into their lunch account. Your help and cooperation with this are much appreciated!

If you would like to see a menu or an a la carte price list, please go to the Carmel Clay Schools website and click on "Parents" and "Lunch Tools". Go to the Middle School Menu tab and you can view our menu, a la carte price list and nutritional information.

If anyone is interested in working for CCS Food Services, please check out our flyer with information on how to apply! I personally have been part of the Food Service staff with Carmel Clay Schools for 26+ years and I can attest to the fact that it's a great place to work! The hours are perfect if you have students...we're done before the kiddos get off the bus and we have all the same holidays. Hello! My name is Julie Dickson (aka "Nurse Julie") and I'm excited for my 4th year at Clay! Thank you for entrusting me to care for your sweet kiddos. Their safety and well-being is my top priority. This year the Hamilton County Health Department would like us to stress the importance of routine vaccinations to prevent disease and illness. Every year immunizations are due for the State of Indiana upon the 20th day of school, and this year that date is September 7th. You may turn in immunization records to me via email or in person at school. It is okay to send records with your student to turn into the office or clinic at school. We do offer a religious exemption form for any/all vaccinations which can be found on our Clay website. Please click "Student Services" then "Nurse" and all information can be found under the "Immunization Information" tab. If you do not have immunizations completed by the 20th day of school, or your child has not yet turned 11, please contact me with the date

The Team Atlas Green Team is collecting gently used athletic shoes to donate to the MORE Foundation Group now through the end of August!




- Step 1 Donate your gently used athletic shoes by placing them in the collection boxes found in the 7th grade hallway and across from the main office.
