We have had a GREAT first semester and have so much to be proud of! Listed below are just a few highlights:

- CHS attained a 95% Graduation rate for the 2022-23 school year!
- 88% of our senior class graduated with at least 1 college credit (highest in the district for the 5th year)

His stats spoke volumes – 7 sacks and 29 tackles – showcasing his disruptive presence on the field.
