Minutemen Muster Wednesday, August 3rd

This is what we used to call Registration. Our students are already registered, so we will now call this entire event **Minutemen Muster**. During this event, students will be able to pick up their class schedules, pick out their locker, and buy a parking pass, register for a bus, and more. Students can also "walk" their schedules and meet their teachers.

The Muster takes place during the day with the following schedule:

- Grades 10-12: 8:30 am 11:30 am
- Grades 7-9: 12:30 pm 3:30 pm.

Lockers: Students who wish to use a locker, must use a school lock. If they purchased one last year, and still have it, they can use it. If they need a lock, they can purchase a used school lock for \$2.00, or a brandnew lock for \$5.00

PE Uniforms: Students enrolled in PE classes must dress out and wear the Cocoa Beach PE uniform t-shirt and shorts. A set (t-shirt and shorts) is \$25.00 and can be purchased at Muster and also during the first few days of class.

<u>Parking Permit:</u> Students who wish to park in the school parking lot must purchase a permit each year. The cost is \$20.00 for the year and can be purchased at Muster, or during the first week of school. Also, Seniors can pay an additional \$20.00 to paint their parking space with a custom design. This can also be done at muster.

<u>Please Note:</u> We cannot accept credit card payments for any fees. We can only accept cash or checks.

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2D Art Students Earn AP Distinction


