Health and safety guidelines at the time prevented us from conducting our normal graduation ceremony. Out of this uncertain and challenging time came an incredible celebration of our graduates. I will never forget the joy on the faces of the Class of 2020 as they were finally able to break free from isolation of quarantine and lockdown to celebrate one of life's most important milestones. The Beach Walk is now a Cocoa Beach tradition that rivals the Crossing of the Bridge and other Minutemen rites of passage.

We remain the top program in Brevard County based on our Cadet's performance and commitment to supporting their school and community. We are the largest JROTC program by Cadet numbers in Brevard County, and we do that as one of the smallest high schools. Brevard Academic Team Finishes 2nd at Championship Tournament


