

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ECounselor







Please, make sure you have parent/guardian email addresses associated with your student's record, so you are not missing these important flyers. The primary contact can keep their email address updated via the Student Reservation System (SRS). Please, visit the front office if you have more than one contact, as additional email addresses need to be added/updated at your child's school.

To ensure smooth delivery of Peachjar flyers, we suggest you add the following address school@peachjar.com to your email contacts. When you receive your first Peachjar flyer email, be sure to click "always display images."

PCS User ID & Password

How do I Obtain a PCS Parent User ID and Password?

Current Students

If you already have a PCS Parent User ID and Password, you do not need to get another User ID or Password for additional members in your family. Only one User ID and Password is issued per family. Simply use your User ID and Password to log in to the Student Reservation System to register your child. Then take the required documents to your child's assigned school (see document list below). [Change/Reset Student Password](#)

New or Returning Students

If you have a new or returning student to Pinellas County and need to make a reservation for a public school and do not have a Parent User ID and Password, you will first need to do the following: To obtain a username or reset your password, take a photo id (driver's license, state id, passport, etc.) into any PCS school and ask for one. You can also take a picture or scan it and send your request to: StudentAssignment@pcsb.org. After you have obtained a User ID and Password, you can use the school's computer or your home computer to complete your child's reservation, which will hold your child's seat at their zone school.

Why do I need a Parent User ID and Password?

A Parent User ID and Password is used with Focus and the Student Reservation System. In Focus when the student has been attached to the Parent User ID, a parent is able to log into Focus and view a variety of different items pertaining to the student. Some of these items could include: grades, attendance, homework assignments and access to links to their students' teachers. Parents will use the Student Reservation System (SRS) for the following:

- Reserving a seat for enrolling a new or returning students for the Current School Year
- Reserving a seat for enrolling a new student for the Next School Year
- Changing your residence address
- Applying for District Application Programs (magnets, fundamental, or high school career programs)
- Applying for a Special Assignment Request

Does My Parent User ID Ever Expire?

Yes, Parent User Accounts that have not been used to log on to any district system (SRS or FOCUS) will be purged and deleted after 12 months of inactivity. If your ID is purged, you can have a new ID and Password issued by following the process described above and visiting any school or the Student Assignment Office with a valid photo ID.

How do I change my Passwords for Focus/SRS? Parents who wish to change their current password may do so by clicking on "Forgot your Password?" near the bottom of the page in Focus. Then enroll into the Self Service Reset Password Management (SSRPM), after enrolling you will be able to reset your password. Parents must create a complex password that is a minimum of ten characters long. New passwords will require at least one character from three of the following four categories: lower case alphabetic (a-z), upper case alphabetic (A-Z), numeric (0-9) and special characters (examples: !,@,#).

If you are unable to change your password online or if you do not know your username or password, you must visit your school to have your identity confirmed and password changed. Please, bring your identification with you to the school.



Permission To Leave

If you know in advance that your student will need to leave during the school day, please provide a note to Ms. Litchy in the Student Services office or email litchym@pcsb.org with: Name of the student, grade level, why they are leaving, time they are leaving and the phone number of the parent or legal guardian where they can be reached for verification.

We will provide a yellow permission-to-leave pass for your student. Please sign the yellow pass and have your student return it to the Front Office/Visitor Entrance when he/she returns to school. Please send in doctors' notes when students have had an appointment or seen the doctor or been in the hospital.

NO permission-to-leave passes will be granted over the phone.

How to Take a College Day

Countryside High School (juniors & seniors) are eligible to take a total of 3 college days: one day during their junior year and 2 days during their senior year.

Procedure:

1. Bring a note from your parent/guardian at least 3 days before the visit stating where (what college you will be attending) and what day you are going. Pick up a college day form from Ms. Litchy in the Student Services office.
2. You need to have all seven of your teachers sign the form as well as your parent/guardian.
3. When completed, turn the form in to Ms. Litchy in the Student Services Office BEFORE YOU GO.
4. When you go to the college you MUST get a note from the college on their letterhead stating that you visited their campus that day. This note should be turned in as soon as you return to school to Ms. Litchy in the Student Services Office.



Absences

If your child will be absent, please, report it on our website at <https://www.pcsb.org/countryside-hs>, and click on the top right link "Report Student Absence." Please, include the following: **Student's Name, Date of Birth, Grade, Absence Date, and Reason.** If applicable, please, attach any documentation to support the absence.

You may also call the school at 727-725-7956 #2051 and let us know that your student will be absent. If there is no answer, please leave a message with the following information: Student's name, grade, reason the student will be absent, your name and relationship to the student. When the student returns, please send an absence note with the same information, and have your student deliver the note to Student Services. Also, please send in doctors' notes when students have had an appointment or seen the doctor or been in the hospital.

If your student is absent, you might still receive a phone call at the end of the day even if you have called to notify us. Please allow us 48 hours to get the attendance updated. If you know that your child is absent from school, there is no need to call the school.

2022 Summer Driver Education Registration Starts Online in February

Pinellas County Schools will offer driver education camp at nine locations this summer. There will be two sessions at each site that are open to both public and private school students at a cost of \$175.00 per student. The sessions are scheduled from 7:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., but students will be divided into half day sessions (A or B) to allow teachers to work with smaller groups. The camps are open to residents of Pinellas County. Please note seniors **who have graduated from high school are not eligible**.

Students will register online starting **Feb. 21- 27, 2022**. The online application can be accessed on the **Pinellas County Schools website**. Students will be selected for the Summer Driver's Education Program through a lottery process. Every student who registers online between February 21st. and, February 27th will have the same chance of being selected. Applications will not be accepted at the school sites. Students will be notified of their placement via email starting March 11th. **Students must accept their spot by paying their lab fee for the course by using the link on the notification email by the deadline of 11:59 p.m., April 10th.** The lab fee of \$175.00 is **NON-REFUNDABLE**.

Students can register online for one session at their school of choice.
