#### **BEST STANDARDS**

- This year Citrus County will be implementing Florida's Benchmarks for Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T.) Standards for English Language Arts and Mathematics.
- These benchmarks will eliminate Common Core and increase the quality of curriculum and instruction. B.E.S.T. prioritizes civics and frames learning around
- classic literature and primary source material. Students will learn from every major literacy period and analyze rhetoric starting in 6th grade. B.E.S.T. Mathematics
- ends confusing Math that was a roadblock for parents to help students at home and gives flexibility to students to show their unique strategies for problem solving
- and real-world context. Which will make Math more valuable to education overall. B.E.S.T. will also eliminate Florida Student Assessment (FSA) Testing. Florida
- is becoming the first state in the nation to fully implement progress monitoring instead of end-of-year standardized testing. Florida's Assessment of Student
- Thinking (F.A.S.T) is a progress monitoring assessment that will take place three
- times a year: Fall, Winter, and Spring. Testing will take hours rather than days to administer and require 75% less testing time.
