


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#### **Attendance** Policy

SCHOOL START DATE FOR STUDENTS: AUGUST 10TH, 2023 (Thursday) Students shall be counted in attendance if they are present at school at the time the attendance is taken or are away from school on a school day and engaged in an educational activity that constitutes a part of the school approved instructional program for the student (Section 1003.23, Florida Statutes). As per the School Board Policy 4.16, after nine absences in a course, credit may be withheld. The Child Study Team will develop a contract with the student and parents that includes a plan to restore the credit withheld. All students are expected to be on time and present each day school is open during the school year. Excessive absences will also result in driver's licenses being revoked from the State. Please review our full attendance policy information on our school website. You may reach out to the Attendance Office or School Social Worker for attendance questions.



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

Follow these instructions to set up your account:


When you go to myschoolbucks.com, you must "make an account." When asked to choose



your county, you must select **School District of Lee County**, NOT Lee County. Once you have done this, go to the little head on the top right-hand side of the screen and click on that. Then, click on "my students" and add your child as a student. This is when you'll be able to choose the school. Once you have done this, go back to the home screen and click on "store." Under the store tab, click browse all. You will find everything that you need here.
