It is hard to believe we are well into the second half of the school year, and we look forward to the spring season and warmer weather! As spring approaches, we begin our preparation for testing season. The most important of which is the Ohio state end-of-year tests which we refer to as the End-of-Course assessments. Most of our student's grades 9-11 will participate in at least one EOC. In addition to these assessments, many of our students will take the ACT (11th graders only) and many will participate in Advanced Placement (AP) tests. Below are the key dates and tests over the last months of the school year:

- ACT test for all 11th Graders:
 February 28th (Visit bit.ly/30mYCGB for more info.)
- ACT Test with Accommodations (11th Graders):
 March 1 3rd and 6 10th
- End of Course Testing: April 10 16th
- End of Course Testing Retesting: April 16 26th
- AP Testing: May 6 17th

The End of Course tests are vitally important as they directly impact a student's graduation status. Each student currently enrolled in the following classes will be required to take the online exams: Algebra I, Geometry, 10th Grade English, Biology, American History, and American Government. We anticipate having the scores from the Winter Testing Session in December back from the state during the second week of February. On April 9th, 2023, all students will receive a testing letter to update them on their current EOC points standing and the progress toward graduation requirements.

This letter will also notify the students:

- Which test they are scheduled to take in the spring
- Specific Day of each test
- Specific Testing location
- Progress report that shows all points earned to date from previous EOC tests
- Retests (if needed)

Please encourage your student(s) to listen to announcements and talk to their teachers about possible remediation and review sessions beginning at the end of February. Additional review and study sessions will be scheduled as the testing session approaches.

During the EOC testing week, all testing students should report to their assigned location by 8 o'clock. Students who are not testing on a specific day are not required to report to school until 11:30 am, which is the conclusion of the testing period. There will be a study hall provided for all non-testing students who arrive at the normal school start time. If you have not received your student's testing information by April 9th, or have any other questions, please contact our guidance department or the testing coordinator, Assistant Principal Mr. Kareem Sanders.



2023 - 2024 PARKING PASSES

Parking Permits for the 23-24 school year are available for purchase using Payschools (www.payschoolscentral. com). **ALL** students driving to FHS (including by not limited to PSEO/CCP students, Flex and CBIP) are **REQUIRED** to purchase a yearly parking permit.

Parking Permit **Applications** available for completion through Final Forms (www.fairfield-oh.finalforms.com). Only complete this form for the **STUDENT DRIVING** - please do not complete for siblings riding in the same vehicle and/ or if carpooling with another student - if the sibling and/or other student will be driving to school at any time in a separate vehicle, please complete the Parking Application individually for that student. Please make sure that **ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION** has also been uploaded into your student's file folder in Final Forms. If further instruction is needed, please see https://bit.ly/3BYRyJK. Parking Permits will not be processed if information/ documentation is missina.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

- 1) Student's Driver's License
- 2) Auto Insurance for vehicle being driven
- 3) Current Vehicle Registration

Please allow up to two (2) school days for processing. Students may stop in the office BEFORE or AFTER school only to pick up their parking pass hang tag. PASSES WILL NOT BE DISTRIBUTED DURING ANY OF THE LUNCH BELLS.

Students are only permitted to park in the student lot. Parking is on a first come basis with the exception of seniors who have previously purchased a PAINT SPOT. There is **NO PARKING** at any time in a reserved area: Staff/Visitor area, Drop-Off/Pick-Up areas, Handicap spaces, Fire Lane, etc. **ALL** student parking is in the **FRONI** of the school building across from the tennis court area and includes the lower Marching Band practice lot. **SENIOR PAINTED SPOTS ARE CONSIDERED A RESERVED AREA.**

Any student found parked or parking in a reserved area, outside of the student parking area, or parking without a Permit will automatically have the parking fee (\$55) assessed to their student account and are subject to discipline action, and/or having the car tagged/towed at the owner's expense.

Students called out for early dismissal will be verified as a registered student driver before being released; students identified by the parent/guardian as a driver but do not have a parking permit will have the \$55 parking fee assessed to their student account. Parking fees are a non-waivable school expense.



TEACHER CONFERENCES

Welcome to Fairfield High School conference scheduling. FHS uses the online scheduling service PTCfast in order to streamline the process for parents/guardians. Please see detailed instructions below for how to register & schedule conferences.

All conferences at the high school are by appointment only with each individual teacher and held in 15-minute increments. Please be considerate of the teachers' & staffs' time; if you feel the need for additional time outside of the standard conference appointment, please contact your student's teacher or guidance counselor directly to see what arrangements can be made to accommodate your needs. **DO NOT sign up with multiple teachers for the same time slot – CONFERENCES WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE CANCELLED.**




