

FINAL TRANSCRIPT REQUEST

SENIORS! Don't forget to complete the Final Transcript Request Form for the college or program you have selected to attend next year. If this step is not completed it may delay and/or prevent your college or program from finalizing your admissions process.

Final Transcript Requests are processed **ONLINE ONLY** thru Google

and will be accessible Monday 5/23/2022 thru Sunday 7/31/2022.

Any request after7/31/2022 will need to use the standard FHS Transcript Request Form (https://bit.ly/3IAd5JA) and submit it along with the transcript fee to the high school.

INSTRUCTIONS:

How to access the Class of 2022 Final Transcript Request:

- 1. All school fees must be paid in full. Your transcript & diploma will be placed on hold until the financial obligation has been fulfilled.
- 2. Please use the following link: https://forms.office.com/r/xXjpCJDBA8
- 3. You must submit a new form for each request. One (1) request only per form.
- 4. Final Transcripts will be mailed directly to the entity named on the request form beginning the week of Monday 6/13/2022. Please allow at least 2 weeks mailing time for transcripts to arrive at their intended destination.
- 5. See online form for information regarding requests for transcripts being mailed to a foreign address.

Final Transcripts are created **AFTER** final grades have posted (based on end of year report cards) and will show the date that your diploma was awarded. Final Transcripts will be mailed directly to the college, military branch, professional organization, trade school, etc. that you have requested on the form. Please make sure that ALL information is correct and accurate before submission. If you are unsure of where you need your transcript sent, IT IS THE STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY to verify the information.

Fairfield High School is not responsible for transcripts not received or delayed due to incorrect/inaccurate information and/or for lost or misdirected transcripts.


