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

The past two school years have been unchartered waters for all of us, but we have all persevered and moved forward! The fall semester flew by in the blink of an eye. No matter how the fall semester ended you now have an opportunity to improve your GPA and attendance.

Let's ALL start this semester with a clean slate. We encourage everyone to enjoy this chance for a fresh start by utilizing their time management skills to maintain good study habits and grades. Students make sure to check your Skyward and school email daily. Please advocate for yourself. Teachers do not know you are concerned about your grades unless you let them know. Teachers want to see you succeed. Make sure you have an open line of communication with each of them.

It is of paramount importance not only to pass all of your classes but to earn C's or higher. Simply earning D in class is almost as detrimental to your GPA as failing that class. Every student must maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA to participate in athletics as well as to graduate in four years. Earning all C's in each of your classes will keep you at a 2.0 GPA. Just one D or F will drop you below a 2.0 GPA. Don't allow yourself to slack off academically by not maintaining your grades the third nine weeks. A huge key to your success is daily attendance. Students who are absent from class tend to fall behind in their work and grades. Chronic absences can mean being absent as few as 4-5 days the first nine weeks. Be here, be on time, be prepared!

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International Baccalaureate News

Changes to IB Spanish B Exams for May 2022

As the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program and Course Program close in on their May 2022 exam sessions, most of the exams are structured like those last year which were mitigated or amended due to the COVID pandemic affecting IB schools on a global scale.

The most significant difference for May 2022 involves IB Spanish B. All IB juniors and seniors scheduled for IB Spanish B Higher Level (HL) and Standard Level (SL) must take the new listening portion of the Paper 2 exam. For HL and SL the listening comprehension exams take 1 hour and 45 minutes respectively. Because of this addition to Spanish exams the weighting of assessments has been slightly altered for May 2022. Please see the chart below for the weighting of each component for the revised IB Spanish B curriculum assessments. At this time, this applies only to students in the May 2022 session.
