FINISH STRONG as we move in the Homestretch!

This school year has flown by and we are in the homestretch!

Let us not get complacent in either our daily attendance or our academics as we finish off the 2022 school year. Just as April showers and sunshine are the food and the nutrients for renewed and strong flowers, so too can it be your preparation for your classes. If you tend to your academics and attendance NOW (like a garden) you will see the fruits of your labor in positive academic results (beautiful flowers) in May. Just like a race, once you hit the homestretch you must finish strong and drive to the finish line (graduation). Now is not the time to let off the gas.

It is of paramount importance not only to pass all of your classes but to earn C's or higher. Simply earning D in class is almost as detrimental to your GPA as failing that class. Every student must maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA to participate in athletics as well as to graduate in four years. Earning all C's in each of your classes will keep you at a 2.0 GPA. Just one D or F will drop you below a 2.0 GPA. A huge key to your success is daily attendance. Students who are absent from class tend to fall behind in their work and grades. Chronic absences can mean being absent as few as 4-5 days. Be here, be on time, be prepared!

The Ocean Center

The Ocean Center requires everyone who needs a seat to have a ticket. Please understand that tickets are limited. Graduates do not need a ticket.

Ticket distribution will begin at the senior meeting on May 4 / May 5. With the growing size of our graduating classes, we have had to adjust the number of tickets available to each graduate. **For the 2022 graduation, each graduate is guaranteed up to 8 admission tickets free of charge.**

Ticket Distribution Process:

- Round 1- Each student that has no senior debt and has completed the graduation requirements will receive 8 tickets at the senior meeting on May 4th / May 5th. Each graduating senior is allowed up to 8 tickets in this round **IF ALL YOUR DEBT IS PAID. Please don't take more than you need.** If you can not attend the meeting you may pick up your ROUND 1, 8 tickets at a late date: (To be determined after the meeting)

It will take you close to an hour to drive to the Ocean Center from Palm Coast due to traffic. Please plan to arrive early. Graduates report to the expo hall on the west side of the building, spectators go to the arena.

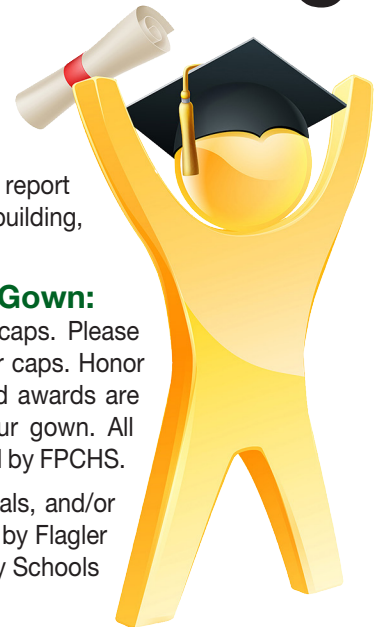
What to Wear under your Cap/Gown:
