

The school year is flying by! Let's continue the strong start we had in the first quarter by blowing into the 2nd 9-Weeks like a cool wind from the north. However, don't tumble around like aimless autumn leaves. Make sure you bring a purpose and focus to your academics. No matter how the 1st 9-Weeks ended you can improve on and bring consistency to your schooling.

We encourage all students to work on their time management skills and to maintain good study habits and grades. Please make sure to check your Skyward, Schoology, and school email daily. Make sure to engage your teachers by advocating for yourself and having an open line of communication with each of them. Teachers want to see you succeed!

It is of paramount importance that if you had a lower than expected grade in the first quarter that you shoot for one grade higher in quarter two so that your overall average increases at the end of the semester in December.

A huge key to your success is daily attendance. Students who are absent from class tend to fall behind in their work and grades. Chronic absences can mean being absent as few as 4-5 days the first nine weeks. Be here, be on time, be prepared!

Students needing additional supports in their core subject areas or in online classes have the opportunity to stay after school on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2:30-4:30pm. After school buses are provided at 4:30pm for transportation home on these days. FPC also offers online tutoring Monday - Thursday anywhere you have WIFI.

## **International Baccalaureate News**

### **College Board National Merit Semi-Finalists**

Congratulations to the four seniors from the Flagler Palm Coast High School IB Diploma Program Class of 2022 for their recognition as PSAT/ NMSQT College Board National Merit semi-finalists for 2022. We wish **Sean Gilliam, Paul Grau, Kenneth Logan,** and **Daniel Wolcott** the bestof luck as we await College Board's final decision in December.

### **IB Internal Assessments**

IB scores are determined by two types of assessments: external and internal. External assessments are generally the exam that diploma candidates and course candidates take in May with some exceptions occurring in the Visual Arts and Music where students complete long-term assignments for external assessment points and in English for the Higher Level essay.

Internal assessments are comprised of labs, projects, oral recordings, exhibitions, and project presentations required by the IB. Although teachers mark and comment on these assessments prior to submitting them to the IB, IB examiners and moderators also scores these components to serve as a system of checks and balances to ensure equity in teachers' marks and scores. IAs tend to comprise Anywhere from 20% to 30% of a student's final overall score with the external assessments making up the rest. Because there are many IAs when considering the IB curriculum, teachers try to spread out due dates to allow students adequate time to prepare and to plan well before the deadlines.


