# From Your Principal, Dean Ledford

Hello Senators!

We have been working hard throughout this school year in academics, athletics, and through our performing arts programs. We are currently progressing towards our 2nd round of PMAs (Progress Monitoring Assessment) and are looking to show improvements in all academic areas. We encourage you to come out and enjoy an athletic event or

extra-curricular performance during the next few months. You can check out our school website www.duvalschools.org/fhs for announcements about upcoming events and performances.

Through our increase in overall competition we like to challenge our students to show improvement during their 2nd round of PMAs. For every PMA that we outperform the previous year's assessment, we will add 10 minutes to a specific lunch day. Those days will be announced. The 2nd round of PMAs will provide a snapshot of students' progress at the midyear point. The PMAs will be given January 7 through January 11. Teachers will review this data and plan a path to success for the remainder of the school year. This strategy will help ensure students demonstrate mastery in their classes and on state assessments. They should be able to articulate to you how they are doing now, and what they need to do in order to show improvement.

January marks the beginning of our second semester. Each year, during the second semester all schools experience an increase in absences and late arrivals, and a gradual decline in academic performance. So prevalent is this trend, it has been referred to as the "Second Semester Slide". We are determined to improve this trend and you the parents can play a major role. Absences and tardiness are two of the reasons that grades decline. Please be vigilant in making sure your student attends school every day and arrives on time. Your attention to this issue will have a positive effect on your student, reinforcing the importance you place on attendance.

To assure continued academic success and not fall victim to "Second Semester Slide", reestablish your student's homework and study routine. Help him/her to reclaim the space and time meant for this important purpose. Determine if any supplies or devices are needed. They make great holiday gifts. Also, monitor your student's grades, attendance, and classwork by accessing Parent Portal. Use the Duval County Public School website to create an account if needed. Learn about our tutoring times and schedule that is posted in this publication. Again, your attention to your student's school work will have a tremendous positive effect. When students are prepared for class each day, they will attend each day, arrive on time, and perform with confidence.

These efforts; staying informed about your student's progress, re-establishing a solid home-study routine, and making certain that your student attends every day and arrives on time will have an enormous positive result and help us all overcome "Second Semester Slide".

Again, thank you for your continued support and we look forward to seeing you at our various winter events and programs. Feel free to contact your student's teachers for available times to meet with you to discuss your student's progress. We will continue to raise the standard of excellence at Fletcher High School in order to achieve our goal of being recognized as one of the premier high schools in the county. 

# PLANNING ON COLLEGE? THIS IS WHAT YOU SHOULD BE DOING NOW!

- Take/retake the SAT (www.collegeboard.org) and/or ACT (www.actstudent.org)
- Making final decisions on the colleges to which you want to apply. If you know where you are going to apply, you should go ahead and apply this semester.
- Applying to college
  - Apply online at the college's website (www.flvc.org has all of the state schools' website addresses).
  - Mail in your check for their application fee.
  - Come to the registrar in Guidance and sign-up to have your transcript sent.
- Visiting college websites.
- Signing up for college seminars in Guidance with Ms. Gonzalez.
- Making sure your schedule contains all of the classes needed for graduation.

#### WHAT ARE COUNSELORS DOING?

Classroom Lessons

Counselors will be going into all of the 10th grade English classes during the month of December. Counselors will discuss graduation requirements, community service hours, scholarships, resources for planning for college and careers, dual enrollment, and promotion requirements. Senior Warning Letters

Warning letters were mailed home to the parents of Seniors who made a "D" and/or "F" on their first quarter report card. Warning letters were also mailed out to any senior who has not passed the FSA Reading, Algebra 1 EOC, has below a 2.0 unweighted GPA, or is taking a course that is required for graduation online. During the month of November, counselors called these students in to sign the warning letters and develop a plan of action.




