From Your Principal, Dean Ledford

Hello Senators!! We have completed 3 quarters of the school year at Fletcher High School. The Class of 2023 will be graduating on May 30th at 5:00 p.m. in the Jacksonville Veteran's Arena. For the parents of Seniors please contact your son or daughter's counselor to ensure all graduation requirements are on track for completion prior to graduation. As a school we will use the mail, email, and

phone system to advise parents if their child is in jeopardy of not graduating.

We are also approaching our end-of-year assessments. The chart below contains the Florida State Assessments and the window in which they will be given. Please keep in mind that many of these tests are completed on-line so testing will be conducted during the entire window for students. Speak to your son or daughter prior to any plans around checking them out of school early during these test dates. If a test is started and not finished due to a student being checked out of school, the test may be marked as invalid and cannot be scored nor can they complete the test another time. To avoid this situation please check with your child prior to checking your student out of school. The testing dates below do not include the make-up times for students that are absent. Each test does have a make-up time window. As always with testing we ask for your flexibility. Administering examinations to over 2000 students frequently results in last minute adjustments in our testing schedule. The test schedule below does not include teacher quarter, semester, or teacher end-of-course exams. Those assessments are determined by the individual teacher.

Fletcher has 4 students that earned a spot on the 2023 National Merit Finalist Lists (Grant Tucker, Patrick Byrd, Zachary Andrews, and Matthew Marrs). Fletcher's Marching band earned an "A" Grade at this year's PMAs. COLLEGE APPLICATIONS

Hopefully, by now (after several reminders) Seniors have applied to the university or community college they hope to attend next year. Most colleges and universities expect students to apply on the specific school's website or preferred platform, during their senior year.

BRIGHT FUTURES APPLICATIONS

All seniors received step-by-step instructions on how to apply for Bright Futures. Students who currently qualify for the scholarship have applied online. Qualified Seniors MUST APPLY online at www.FloridaStudentFinancialAid.org. The website also outlines the requirements for Bright Futures.

Please remember that Bright Futures requires community service hours be documented on their official form and turned in to the student's counselor PRIOR to graduation. We ask that students turn their community service hour forms in by May 1, 2023.

WARNING LETTERS

Seniors

Any senior who has deficiencies that may prevent them from graduating (course requirements, 2.0 GPA, FSA Reading and Algebra 1 EOC requirements) was mailed a letter outlining these problems at the end of the first semester (2nd nine weeks). During the month of January, counselors called these students in to sign the warning letters and develop a plan of action.


SCHEDULING FOR 2023-2024

SAT AND ACT

All Juniors are encouraged to take the SAT and/or the ACT in the spring of their Junior year. When we say spring, we mean February. It's not too late to sign up though! Register online at www.collegeboard.com or www.act.org. Be sure to use our high school code, 100-800, when registering. Don't forget that students must upload a photo of themselves on the testing agency's website.

SCHOLARSHIPS

As we navigate the newly imposed restrictions on SharePoint, the Scholarship Newsletter is currently being disseminated, via email, to students on a biweekly basis. If a paper version of the scholarship application is available, it will be indicated on the newsletter and students/parents will be able to pick it up in the Guidance Office. Many scholarships are offered directly from the colleges to which you are applying.

SCHOLARSHIPS & COLLEGE ACCEPTANCES

Any Senior who has received a college acceptance and/or any type of monetary award or grant should report them to their school counselor so that we can record them. The grand total of college acceptances and scholarship monies won by our senior class will be revealed during the graduation ceremony!

ONLINE COURSE REQUIREMENT

All students must complete a full course online for graduation. Please take a look at the courses offered on flvs.net and have your student select the course he/she would like to complete. These courses are absolutely free and once your student completes the course, his/her counselor will receive the grade and have it placed on your student's transcript. For this graduation class, successfully completing standard or honors government at Fletcher High School will satisfy the online graduation requirement.

COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS

Don't wait until your Senior year to complete community service hours. Get started now! Community service hours are not required for graduation, but they are required for Bright Futures. Students can pick up community service logs in the Guidance office. There is a list of potential places students can volunteer located on the back of the community service log (e.g., Jacksonville Humane Society, Hubbard House, and BEAM).


