Hello Senators!!

We are closing in on the end of the third quarter at Fletcher High School. The Class of 2024 will be graduating on June 3rd at 5:00 p.m. in the Jacksonville Veteran's Arena. For the parents of Seniors please contact your son or daughter's

counselor to ensure all graduation requirements are on track for completion prior to graduation. As a school we will use the mail, email, and phone system to advise parents if their child is in jeopardy of not graduating.

We are also approaching our end-of-year assessments. The chart below contains the Florida State Assessments and the window in which they will be given. Please keep in mind that many of these tests are completed on-line so testing will be conducted during the entire window for students. Speak to your son or daughter prior to any plans around checking them out of school early during these test dates. If a test is started and not finished due to a student being checked out of school, the test may be marked as invalid and cannot be scored nor can they complete the test another time. To avoid this situation please check with your child prior to checking your student out of school. The testing dates below do not include the make-up times for students that are absent. Each test does have a make-up time window. As always with testing we ask for your flexibility. Administering examinations to over 2000 students frequently results in last-minute adjustments in our testing schedule. The test schedule below does not include teacher quarter, semester, or teacher end-of-course exams. Those assessments are determined by the individual teacher.

A huge congratulations to Max Shaver for beating the Fletcher High School diving record and winning the State Diving Championship. The Fletcher Boy's Golf Team and Wrestling Team won the Gateway Conference Championship. Fletcher had over 20 athletes sign national letters of intent on national signing day.

Bri Thomas placed 13th in the nation at the NFTE Youth Entrepreneurship Challenge in New York City. Congratulations to James Armstrong and Resse Coleman for being one of 32 and one of 42 portfolios accepted at the State Fair – Art Portfolio Contest for High School Seniors. The Fletcher Mock Trial Team competed in Chicago, Illinois and went undefeated in 4 trials, also winning the 4th Judicial Circuit Competition and will be representing the 4th Judicial Circuit in March at the Florida State High School Mock Trial Competition. Fletcher had two students, Emily Machinski and Isaac George, earn Letters of Commendation from the National Merit Scholarship Program. We had over 25 of our AICE students earn scholar awards for their performance on the 22/23 AICE Exams with one student earning the highest mark in the world – Zachary Andrews.

BRIGHT FUTURES APPLICATIONS

All seniors received step-by-step instructions on how to apply for Bright Futures. Qualified Seniors MUST APPLY online at www. FloridaStudentFinancialAid.org. The website also outlines the requirements for Bright Futures.

Please remember that Bright Futures requires community service hours and/or work hours to be documented on their official form and turned in to the student's counselor PRIOR to graduation. We ask that students turn their community service hour forms in by May 1, 2024.

Seniors

Any senior who has deficiencies that may prevent them from graduating (course requirements, 2.0 GPA, FSA Reading and Algebra 1 EOC requirements) was mailed a letter outlining these problems at the end of the first semester (2nd nine weeks). During the month of January, counselors called these students in to sign the warning letters and develop a plan of action.



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


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
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Duval County Public Schools 2023-2024
