COLLEGE APPLICATIONS

Hopefully, by now (after several reminders) Seniors have applied to the university or community college they hope to attend next year. Most colleges and universities expect students to apply on the specific school's website, during their senior year.

BRIGHT FUTURES APPLICATIONS

All seniors received step-by-step instructions on how to apply for Bright Futures. Students who currently qualify for the scholarship have applied online. Qualified Seniors MUST APPLY online at www. FloridaStudentFinancialAid.org. The website also outlines the requirements for Bright Futures.

Please remember that Bright Futures requires community service hours be documented on their official form and turned in to the student's counselor PRIOR to graduation. We ask that students turn their community service hour forms in by May 1, 2021.

WARNING LETTERS

<u>Seniors</u>

Any senior who has deficiencies that may prevent them from graduating (course requirements, 2.0 GPA, FSA Reading and Algebra 1 EOC requirements) was mailed a letter outlining these problems at the end of the first, second, and/or third quarter. During the month of April, counselors called these students in to sign the warning letters and develop a plan of action.

Final Transcripts

The award amounts reported by our Seniors will be highlighted during the class of 2022 Commencement speech.






