








### FICHS ATHLETICS UPDATE





Just a reminder for anyone attending an athletic event on any School District campus, the following rules apply:

- ALL persons, bags, and vehicles may be subject to search
- Only clear bags are permitted inside the stadium –
   All other bags or purses with the exception of diaper bags, are prohibited
- NO re-entry If you exit, you cannot return
- NO admittance after the second half kickoff
- NO loitering outside of the stadium/school gates or in parking areas
- Exit the stadium immediately at the conclusion of the game
- NO outside food or beverages may be brought into the event
- Unruly conduct, disruptive behavior, use of profane, obscene or abusive language or any type will result in immediate removal from the event
- In the event of an emergency, follow all instructions provided by law enforcement or school staff
