A Message From The Principal

For over 100 years football and other sports have been a part of life at Fort Myers High School (FMHS). We have celebrated many athletic accomplishments that are too many in number to even attempt to name over those years. However, these accomplishments have come at a cost to our athletes, fans, and the school district. If you have been around FMHS athletics for any length of time then you know that the football field and the track at Sam Sirianni field and Edison Stadium have been in need of renovation for many years. The six lane asphalt track has been a safety concern for track athletes and has been the cause of the, once great, Edison Relays to go from being one of the premier attended (by both teams and spectators) track meets in South Florida to being a poorly attended one. The stadium field has had to be replaced several times in the last couple of years to the tune of \$85,000 each time. Approximately \$300,000 in the last five years has been spent in an attempt to make the grass field playable and safe. The ground and field have gone through a myriad of tests and the results have proven that it will not sustain grass. There has also been drainage issues leaving the field unplayable at times and is always a safety concern. The sidelines, which come into play for soccer and lacrosse, are also in very poor shape.

We would like Fort Myers High School to continue the "tradition of excellence" and move forward as the flagship high school in Lee County by upgrading the athletic complex to a turf playing surface and a rubber track. This will cost approximately one million dollars to accomplish this. I am proud to say that we had two donors that stepped up early who have pledged \$300,000 combined and just recently the NFL has granted us another \$250,000 toward the project. I believe that the people who are the Fort Myers High School community have made it the gem of Lee County. I also believe that this same community can come together to raise the other \$400,000 to upgrade the athletic complex to be a facility that matches the gifted and brilliant people that have come through, and will continue to walk the hallways at Fort Myers High School...Go Greenies!!!

IB Testing

IB Testing is rapidly approaching! By now, IAs have been uploaded and submitted to IB and juniors/seniors should be getting ready for their May Assessments. It is very important that students do not miss their assessments. If they miss an assessment, they will not be eligible for their IB Diploma. Students will receive a detailed exam schedule as well as additional important testing information in their TOK class. Please encourage your student to finish strong!

IB juniors will have their next EE deadline on April 22nd. They should have 2,500 words and be working towards at least 3,000 words before summer vacation. TOK Exhibitions will occur this April. This is a mandatory assessment and presentations will take place in their TOK classes. As we approach the end of the school year, our IB juniors will be completing their HL English paper. This assessment is a crucial part of their HL English IB grade. It is very important that students stay on track so that they do not get overwhelmed. If they need help managing their time, please tell them to reach out to Mrs. Postma. If your IB junior is testing out this year, a detailed exam schedule and additional testing information will be distributed in TOK classes.
