## **Hall of Fame Award**

On January 9th, 2021 Coach Sammv Sirianni was inducted into the 45th Annual Florida Athletic Coaches Association Hall of Fame in Daytona Beach, Florida. This particular Hall of Fame Award is the highest honor presented by the F.A.C.A. It is designed to recognize F.A.C.A. members for years of coaching tenure in Florida High Schools, for dedicated service to the F.A.C.A., and for outstanding coaching accomplishments. Coach Sammy began his coaching career in 1986 as an assistant under, his father, a F.A.C.A. Hall of Famer, Sam Sirianni, Sr. for 16 years through 2001 and taking over in 2002. His football teams have compiled 146 wins, 15 District Titles, 9 Conference Titles, 9 Conference Coach of the Year awards, 16 Regional Quarter Final Appearances, 8 Regional Quarter Final wins, 3 Regional Semi-Final wins and 3 Regional Final Appearances. In 1982, Coach Sammy also served as the Golf Coach that led to a state team championship and Individual championship. Sammy's Hall of Fame induction makes the 3rd Hall of Fame induction, including, L.A.C.A Hall of Fame and Fort Myers High School Hall of Fame. One of the greatest highlights of any coaches' career is to be selected to coach in the F.A.C.A. All-Star game. Coach Sammy held this honor as Head Coach in 2013. What makes this induction so unique is how F.A.C.A. and the Sirianni name are forever linked. As a father/son duo they hold the following historic distinctions: only father/son head coaching duo at one school for 52 consecutive years... only father/son to







have won 100+ games at the same school... 1 of 3 father/son members of the F.A.C.A. Hall of Fame....and 1 of 2 father/son that have been Head Coach of the F.A.C.A. All-Star game. These distinctions illustrate why The Sirianni legacy will live on forever within Fort Myers High School.

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
