Scholarship Section Information

The Collaboratory's (formerly known as the Southwest Florida Community Foundation) scholarship application is open now and closes on January 12, 2022 at 5:00 pm. This scholarship application portal has over 100 scholarships available and the application is online. You can apply for many scholarships with just one application. Last year, Fort Myers High School students submitted the 2nd highest number of applications at 48 total – behind North Fort Myers High at 64 applications submitted. Let's beat the Red Knights this year!

Some key highlights:

- The entire application is online. Applicants will upload any additional requirements, including letters of recommendation, into their application.
- Applicants have the ability to log in and out of their application and save to go back to at any time.
- The lowest GPA requirement (unweighted) is a 2.0 and the highest is a 3.5.
- There are over 150 awards available.
- All awards look for different types of students. Major, school choice, GPA and community involvement are some of the things scholarships look for.
- Requirements for the application are the applicant's most recent transcript, FAFSA Student Aid Report (required for all applicants) and one letter of recommendation. Some scholarships may require something additional, for verification purposes.

Earlier this year we lost longtime director for City of Fort Myers golf. Rich Lamb served in the role for over 40 years. The "people's pro" is how he was viewed. It was not unusual to see Rich's car at the "Fort" before dawn and after dark. He advocated for the upgrades at both city golf courses. Rich believed in community and tradition and knew the importance of supporting our junior golfers. This tournament would not be in existence if not for Rich Lamb.

Coach Sam's Legacy

Your tremendous generosity and support has enabled *The Sam Sirianni Athletic Scholarship Foundation* to award 184 student athlete scholarships totaling \$333,500, since 2003. All proceeds go toward funding student scholarships. There could not be a more fitting tribute to continue the legacy of Coach Sam, who held the Head Football Coaching position for 33 years recording, 244 wins. He also served as Head Golf Coach and took his team to the state championship where they won both state title and individual title. He will be remembered for his dedication to the success of Lee County students.
