

The **ROJ Scholarship Program** was established by CFY in honor of Mr. Dick Jacobson, founder of the Richard O. Jacobson Foundation and a major contributor to CFY's endowment mission. Since its inception, the program has provided over \$700,000 in awards to deserving Pinellas County High School Seniors to further their path towards a career of their choosing at a postsecondary institution. GIBBS GLADIATOR MENTOR OF THE YEAR NOMINATION

Mr. Fletcher is a retired St. Petersburg Firefighter and former Gladiator who started mentoring with a group he helped organize in 2013. Men of Yesterday, Today, and the Future (MOYTF) was born in 2013, when a group of former friends, athletes, and classmates who graduated from Gibbs High School throughout the late 50s and 60s gathered to answer the call of a Juvenile Court Judge Patrice Moore. This is a team of committed mentors assisting young men as an alternative to juvenile detention. His mission is seen in his actions when he shows up weekly to mentor many of our students across Pinellas County, not just Gibbs High School. With almost a decade of mentoring in our TSIC program as well as Lunch Pals with Pinellas County Schools, he has been matched with over 25 mentees since 2013. He has had over 1100 mentor volunteer hours which does not include hours prior to 2016. If this does not speak to the devotion of Mr. Fletcher, I am not sure what does.
