



## Being Tardy to School or to Class:

We are seeing an increase in the number of times students are tardy to school as well as being tardy to class between the bells in the daily schedule. Students need to be on time to avoid detentions. #### Testing Accommodations for Students with Disabilities

A student with a documented disability may be eligible for accommodations on national college exams including ACT, SAT, PSAT, AP, and/or Certification Exams including Adobe, Microsoft, Autodesk, QuickBooks and ServSafe Exam.

ACT and SAT Accommodation Request must be started early. The request process may take up to seven (7) weeks and the decision determination does not begin until all required documentation is received.


#### National Merit Semi-Finalist
