

Students must meet requirements and deadlines before registering for classes at Florida Southwestern College or Florida Gulf Coast University.

Florida Gulf Coast University has a selection process for their Accelerated Collegiate Experience program. Please schedule an appointment with your counselor for FGCU by February 1, 2024.
