COUNSELOR CORNER

Course selection for the 2021-2022 school year has been completed. Core classes were selected based on Course Progression Guides created by teachers and administrators. Student performance in current classes, and when appropriate state testing, are the basis for course placements. Parents can authorize core classes changes to through submission of the Course Override form. Students were given the opportunity to enter their elective course requests.

Students will have another opportunity in May to review and, with parent permission, adjust their course requests before scheduling occurs. Students that are interested in applying for Dual Enrollment need to check the Dual Enrollment webpage with Seminole State College, the LBHS Virtual Counseling Office in e-Campus, and the Lake Brantley's Student Services Dual Enrollment page. Please reach out to your School Counselor if you have questions.

AP Testing will begin May 4th. Students taking morning exams are expected to arrive by 7:15am and for afternoon exams, students are expected to arrive by 11:15 am. Testing locations will be sent out directly to the teachers and shared with students as well as posted online under Students Services/Advanced Placement/ AP Testing.
