Dear Patriot Family,

What an incredible year it has been so far! Against all odds, students are continuing their education through virtual, digital and face to face learning and it has never been a more exciting time to be a Patriot. The resilience and tenacity of our students, faculty and staff has been incredible to watch throughout the entire first semester, and I am so excited to see what the second semester of the 2020-2021 school has in store for us.

The second semester is an important time in the lives of our students as preparations are being made for the FSA writing (and reading) tests, as well as the preparations for our school-wide SAT school day for the Class of 2022 on April 13th. On top of that, students are already going to be preparing themselves for the 2021-2022 school years in selecting their initial course load requests for next school year. This spring, our course selection process is going to be similar to what we introduced last year as the school is going to be using what we call “course progression guides” to help guide your students in the decision making process for their four core classes (English, Math, Science and Social Studies). We will be using these guides to try and determine a pathway toward graduation that both is appropriate and challenging for your student. During the week of President’s Day in February, students will be able to log in to their personal Skyward accounts and see the course progressions that are suggested in their core academics while simultaneously being able to choose whichever elective pathways they want to pursue. We are doing this to try and minimize the confusion of selecting a course schedule, as well as the anxiety that goes with it. We are always trying to do whatever we can do to help minimize the stress for our students in the scheduling process, and this is the first step in that!

As always, great things are happening at Lake Brantley High School. Thank you all for your patience and support as we worked through these unprecedented times in public education!

COUNSELOR CORNER

Course selection for the 2021-2022 school year will begin February 16th. Core classes were selected based on Course Progression Guides created by teachers and administrators. Student performance in current classes, and when appropriate state testing, are the basis for course placements. Parents can authorize changes to core classes through submission of the Course Override form. Students have the opportunity to enter their elective course requests. Students will have another opportunity in May to review and, with parent permission, adjust their course requests before scheduling occurs.

Bright Futures Scholarship: Processing Timeline

To be considered, seniors must complete the Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA) by August 31st of the year they graduate from high school. Community Service hours must be submitted before graduation. Test scores earned by June 30th will be considered when determining eligibility. Students who attend their college's summer session and only gain initial scholarship eligibility after graduation may be required to pay out of pocket for summer classes and be refunded the following term.

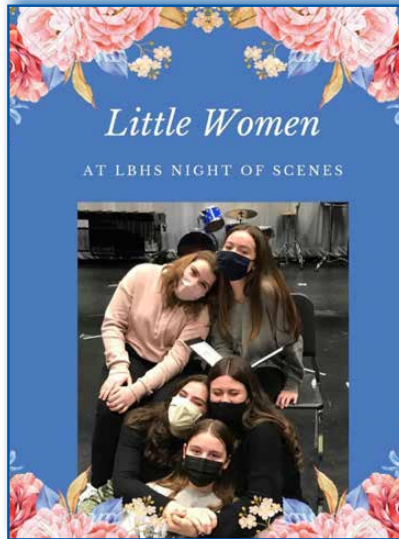
