Dear Patriot Family,

What an incredible start to the school year we have had! Through all of the adversity facing our community and our society, Lake Brantley marches on! The resilience and tenacity of our students, faculty, and staff has been incredible to watch throughout the entire first semester, and I am so excited to see what the second semester of the 2021-2022 school has in store for us.

The second semester is an important time in the lives of our students as preparations are being made for the final FSA writing (and reading) tests, as well as the preparations for several national tests like the ACT and SAT for our classes of 2022 and 2023. On top of that, students are already going to be preparing themselves for the 2022-2023 school years in selecting their initial course load requests for next school year. These tests are so important for our students to meet their graduation concordant score and to be able to report their scores to colleges if they choose to do so. Our school graduation rate of 95% last year was the highest in school history, and we are continuing to grow that number thanks to the effort of our students and teachers!

This spring, our course selection process is going to be similar to what we introduced last year as the school is going to be using what we call "course progression guides" to help guide your students in the decision-making process for their four core classes (English, Math, Science and Social Studies). We will be using these guides to try and determine a pathway toward graduation that both is appropriate and challenging for your student. During the week of President's Day in February, students will be able to log in to their personal Skyward accounts and see the course progressions that are suggested in their core academics while simultaneously being able to choose whichever elective pathways they want to pursue. We are doing this to try and minimize the confusion of selecting a

COUNSELOR'S CORNER

We are beginning the process of course selections for the 2022-2023 school year! During the month of February, all school counselors will be meeting with 9th and 10th grade students individually to select elective courses. Eleventh grade students have already met with their counselor to make their elective course selections. Information will be sent out to families regarding course registration via email and posted to our Student Services webpage. Core academic classes were selected based on Course Progression Guides created by teachers and administrators. Student performance in current classes, and, when appropriate, state testing, are the basis for course placements. Parents can authorize changes to core classes through submission of the course override form. Students will still have the opportunity to make changes to their elective course requests if needed. Students seeking to start Dual Enrollment courses at Seminole State in the summer or fall are encouraged to regularly check our website: http://www.lakebrantley.com/studentservices/dual-enrollment.stml/.

If your student needs to attend summer school, please note that we do not have information from the district yet. Check the Student Services website for updates. Once we have information to share, we will post it to our page. Feel free to email your school counselor with any questions you have.




