Dear Patriot Families.

I hope you have had time to enjoy your summer vacation and are ready to embark on the 2019-2020 school year. As we approach the new school year, our main goal is to have the teachers unpacked and ready to teach in their new classrooms.

- Building #1 will house JROTC and Mr. Holmes.
- Building #5 will house English, ESOL, ESE, and Algebra I.
- Building #6 will house World Languages.
- Building #7 will house Social Studies.
- Building #8 will house Math.

Science, the Arts Programs, and CTE are still spread throughout the school due to where the rooms are located. The cafeteria will also be finished and have inside and outside seating. The final phase which will include the tennis courts will not be done until the end of 1st semester. With the expansion of the campus, the bell schedule has changed to accommodate the students. There will be more time between classes to help them to arrive on time. Please check the website for the new bell schedule.

In May we had students check their current class selections on Skyward to verify the courses they selected. Any student requesting a schedule change, could do this remotely through a google doc that we have posted on our main website for easy access. We also provided summer time assistance by having a guidance counselor available every Monday from 8:00-12:00. During the summer, the offices of LBHS are closed on Fridays. On July 26th the counselors will be back early to resolve any schedule conflicts. When schedule pick up arrives the first week of August, our goal is to have short lines and few changes. We want you to come to LBHS with the security of having a schedule that you can start on day #1. This is especially important for our in-coming freshmen, so they can acclimate to LBHS quickly.

If you are interested in enrolling in full time public virtual school, you need to contact Seminole County Virtual School (SCVS). SCVS is only open for enrollment for two windows during the year. The window for the 2019-2020 Semester 1 is until Wednesday, August 7, 2019. SCVS is located at 450 Technology Park in Lake Mary and the number is 407-871-7287. The website is http://virtualschool.scps.k12.fl.us/. You must enroll in person.

For this year's senior class, the big change will be the ability to paint their parking spaces. Parking pass pick up will occur July 29 - July 31. All parking spots are now numbered and will be assigned to specific students. This will assist in making sure our seniors and juniors have the parking they need. I will send out more correspondence about this as it gets closer to the end of July.





- Develop a list of schools that you will apply to:
 - Reach schools: those you dream of attending but don't think you'll get in or have the money
 - Match schools: those you dream of attending and have a good shot at attending and affording
 - Safety schools: those you are virtually guaranteed admission and will have no problem affording.
- Determine the application requirements for each of your colleges and put scholarship and application deadlines on your calendar. Plan to start college applications August 1st if not earlier.
- If you haven't taken the SAT or ACT with Writing, or if you're not pleased with previous scores, sign up immediately. Delaying this test can delay a college's decision about your admissibility.
- Check your Bright Futures status (GPA, Test scores, and volunteer hours) YOUR SKYWARD GPA IS NOT YOUR BRIGHT FUTURES GPA - https://www.floridashines. org/go-to-college/pay-for-college


