ENVIRONMENTAL CLUB

During April, LBHS' Environmental Club along with the Woodshop classes started building a butterfly garden on campus next to the pond by Building 8. The entrance to the butterfly garden includes two beautiful trellises that have dutchman's pipevines and passion vines growing on them to frame the garden's path. These two vines will be host plants and attract gulf fritillary, zebra longwings, and swallowtail butterflies to our campus. The garden path meanders around a pond where students can sit on benches and enjoy nature. We have also planted several other species of plants like milkweed and fennel that will act as host to various Florida butterfly species like monarchs and swallowtails. Dozens of other nectar

plants will provide a food source for the adult butterflies as well as hummingbirds and encourage them to visit our campus throughout the year.

The Environmental Club is also planning to involve our Pre-K students in the garden and help them to learn about the life cycle of butterflies and about gardening.


