Spring Assessments/EOC's start on Monday May 3rd. This administration includes the following:

- **9th and 10th Grade FSA Reading:** scheduled based on the student's English Teacher
- **Algebra EOC:** May 13th & May 14th, both dates are required to earn a score
- **Biology EOC:** May 17th OR May 20th, date determined based on the student's Biology Teacher
- **Geometry EOC:** May 10th & May 11th, both dates are required to earn a score
- **US History EOC:** May 18th OR May 20th, date determined based on the student's US History Teacher

Student specific dates, times, and locations will be communicated through the student's course area teacher and sent to students' SCPS email accounts. All face to face, Seminole Connect, SCVS, Save My Seat, and full time SCVS students are required to participate in their courses' FSA/EOC. These assessments are only administered on campus; there is no virtual option.

Students who are scheduled for an AP Exam on the same date as their FSA/EOC should attend the AP exam and will automatically be placed on a makeup list for their FSA/EOC.

## LBHS Class of 2021 Graduates and Families,

It is with great excitement that we share with you the most up-to-date details for our Graduation and End of Year celebrations and events for the Class of 2021. Thank you for your patience as we have adjusted and then readjusted to the circumstances of the past year.

### Senior Awards Show, Virtually Sunday, May 2nd 4:00PM

This year's Senior Awards Ceremony will be a virtual broadcast airing Sunday, May 2nd. Seniors and their families will receive a link to the broadcast prior to the ceremony beginning. Seniors receiving an award will receive a letter of notification in late April. It will be rebroadcast as an encore 05/05 at 7PM.

### Credit Recovery Deadline (PLATO/RISE) Thursday, May 6th 2:00PM

Coursework from PLATO/RISE credit recovery must be completed to meet Graduation Requirements. Confirm with your PLATO/RISE facilitator that your credit recovery has been submitted to FTE. Students who fail to complete their credit recovery by this date and time may not graduate on May 24th, but may have their Graduation Date postponed until the summer, pending completion.



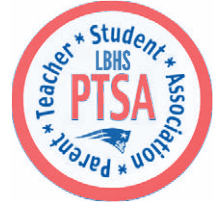

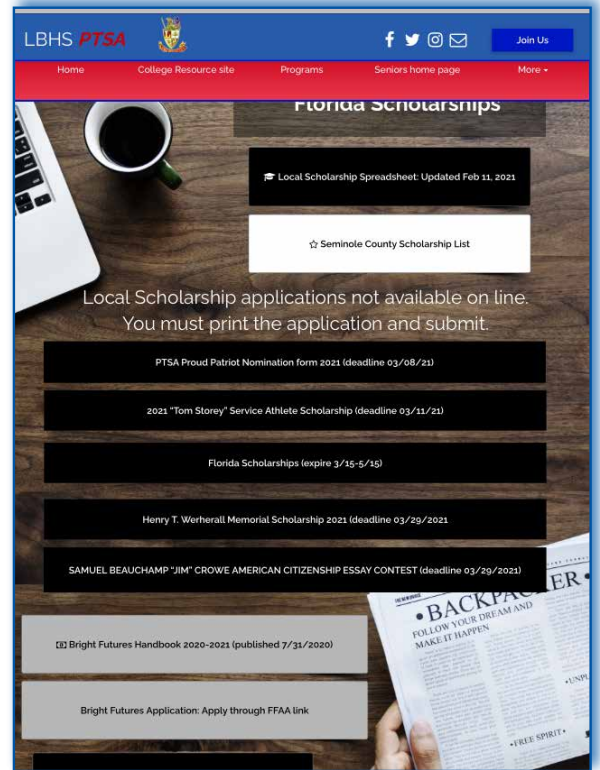

## ENVIRONMENTAL CLUB

During April, LBHS' Environmental Club along with the Woodshop classes started building a butterfly garden on campus next to the pond by Building 8. The entrance to the butterfly garden includes two beautiful trellises that have dutchman's pipevines and passion vines growing on them to frame the garden's path. These two vines will be host plants and attract gulf fritillary, zebra longwings, and swallowtail butterflies to our campus. The garden path meanders around a pond where students can sit on benches and enjoy nature. We have also planted several other species of plants like milkweed and fennel that will act as host to various Florida butterfly species like monarchs and swallowtails. Dozens of other nectar



plants will provide a food source for the adult butterflies as well as hummingbirds and encourage them to visit our campus throughout the year.

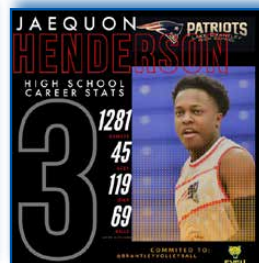
