As we wrap up the end of the first nine weeks of the 2019-2020 school year, there is an incredible amount of positivity to reflect on. - Use Skyward Family Access to monitor your student's progress and celebrate your student's effort. Contact your student's teachers if improvement in performance is needed.
- Encourage your student to take advantage of free tutoring opportunities as soon as they begin to struggle. Not sure if tutoring is offered? Ask their teacher.
- Teach your students to advocate for themselves. While it's instinctual for parents to jump in and problem-solve, empower your student by role-playing constructive conversations that they can then have with teachers. Provide examples of what they can say to express concern over their performance and how to ask for help. They'll gain skills to use throughout life.

- Juniors and seniors, sign up to meet with visiting college and career reps at www.lakebrantley.com/student-services/college-application.shtml
- **11/4 - 11/8: Junior Credit Checks** – counselors will meet individually with all LBHS juniors to review their remaining graduation requirements, discuss course selections for senior year, and begin conversations regarding post-secondary plans.
- **Seniors:** November 1 was a big college application deadline but it's not too late to make post-secondary plans. If you haven't started applying, do so now! Not sure where to apply or what to do? Make an appointment to see your school counselor: www.lakebrantley.com/student-services/contact.shtml. 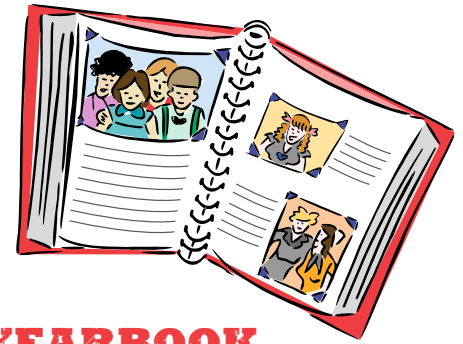

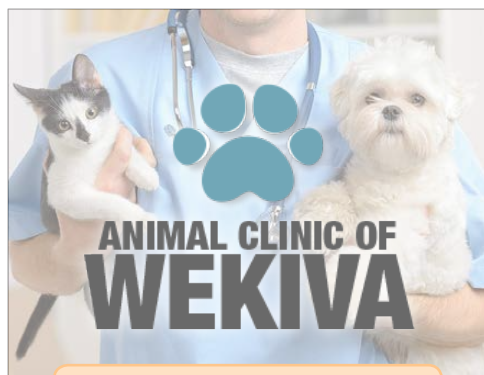
