First, let me extend our sincere congratulations to Lake Howell High School's Unconquerable Class of 2021! The graduation ceremony at the UCF Bounce House was a huge success and enjoyed by all. This year we had 113 Silver Scholars and 83 seniors graduating with a 4.0 GPA or higher. We had a National Merit Finalist and Semi-finalists, a National Hispanic Scholar, and we also had a United States Presidential Scholars candidate – one of only 4,000 in the country!

As we wind down the 2020-2021 school year and look to 2021-2022, the registration process has gone very smoothly, thanks to the efforts of our school counselors and registration office personnel. We truly appreciate the diligence that our parents and students have given toward this important endeavor. We have also wrapped up our end of year testing efforts with similar success and extend our thanks to those individuals as well.

Kudos to our athletic department, coaches, and our athletic teams for a year of success! Boys soccer won the district championship, and boys weightlifting won the conference championship. Individually, our student athletes broke records and competed at the regional and state level in boys and girls weightlifting, track, and cross country. The Silverhawks also won the Florida High School Athletic Association Sunshine Spirit showdown for the second time in four years!

In performing and fine arts, we continued the tradition of earning superior ratings in district and state music performance assessments for band, chorus, and orchestra. The Dynasty Dance Team earned

superior ratings at the Florida State Dance Championships, and our Thespian Troupe 4937 enjoyed a successful run at regionals with their award-winning performances.

Bright Futures Scholarship Information

Any senior who applied for the Bright Futures Scholarship between December 1, 2020 and January 31, 2021 will receive an email of their initial award status. Another email notification will be sent in July for students still working on SAT/ACT scores, grade point average, and community service hours. Initial eligibility does not guarantee an award; students must complete their senior year and meet all requirements before the award is finalized. You can apply at www.floridastudentfinancialaid.org. Please note, there has been an extension for test score and community service requirements to December 1, 2021.

Junior Credit Checks

In January, all third year students met with their counselor. At that time they discussed current credit status, graduation requirements, post-high school plans, and course selection for the 2021-2022 academic year. Any students who were informed of credit deficits should plan to attend summer school.

The US Department of Education notes that many students suffer from "summer slide," a decline in academic ability that happens because they aren't regularly reading. It's easy to prevent summer slide and improve reading skills for next year, though. All you have to do is read!

SCPS offers several options for students to access books digitally (read: they can use their phones!) via Clever (the Portal). Students can borrow books from the TumbleBook Library, Teen Book Cloud, or Overdrive app. These platforms offer traditional books as well as graphic novels and audio books to keep your student reading over the summer.



AP Chemistry News

Following a challenging year and a grueling AP exam, the students in AP chemistry completed a book review project as their 9-week exam. Students were able to select from a variety of "sciencey" books, both fiction and nonfiction, which were graciously donated through an Amazon wish list. The students on Seminole Connect were able to access books through the SCPS Overdrive Digital Library. Some examples of the books chosen include: Radium Girls by Kate Moore, The Violinist's Thumb and The Disappearing Spoon by Sam Kean, and Uncle Tungsten by Oliver Sacks. The students kept a daily log of their reading, which included quotes, diagrams, and explanations of scientific concepts. The final product of the assignment was a book review posted to Amazon or Goodreads highlighting an overview of the book, the science concepts explained, and a personal assessment of the book. Overall, the students enjoyed the opportunity to read a book they normally wouldn't choose and were able to learn the importance of science from a literary perspective.
