



How to... Check if you have Fees and Fines or Overdue Textbooks on Your Chromebook


- 1. Go to your Launchpad.
- 2. Open Instructional Apps.
- 3. Go to Follett Destiny.
- 4. Go to "More" at the top.
- Go to "Back Office" 5.
- 6. Select "My Info" at the top.

There you will see if you have any overdue library books or textbooks. Textbooks that are past due may not show as a fine, but are viewed as a fine.


