



Seniors

On Monday, May 15th or Wednesday, May 17th from 7:30am to 1:30pm seniors will return their Chromebooks, hotspots, and any remaining textbooks, complete a senior exit survey/final transcript request and pickup graduation items.

Students must check in at the main office before proceeding to the media center. Once in the media center, each student will need a check off form, that when completed, will be turned in for graduation items. Students will enter through the front entrance of the media center. Students will need to have their Chromebook, Charger, and Case. The Chromebook needs to be out of the case.

Students will then proceed to the Auditorium after returning Chromebook/textbook/hotspot to complete a senior survey/final transcript request and to pick up their graduation items. If you still need to pay any fees and fines, you will not be given your graduation items until they have been cleared.

To look up fees and/or fines click "Instructional APPS" on your launchpad; click on "Follett Destiny", You should be logged in already. If not, you log in with the same information you log into your Chromebook; click on the top tab "My Info". A list of your current checkouts will appear. Scroll down to see fees and fines. Fees and fines can be paid with Mrs. Sauer in the media center or Mrs. Cooney in the main office.

Students not on campus either day may turn in their Chromebooks/hotspots/textbooks, complete senior exit survey/final transcript request and pick up graduation items between 8:00 AM- 12:00PM in the main office. The last day to turn in all items is May 19, 2023

Graduation tickets will be distributed at the end of practice on Friday, May 19th which is immediately after the Senior Breakfast. Graduation practice is MANDATORY.

Note: You may start to turn all instructional materials on May 8, 2023 if you no longer need them.

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How to Check Fees and Fines

Did you know you are able to check your student record for all current school materials that you have checked out along with any outstanding fees and fines?

- 1. On your Launchpad click on "INSTRUCTIONAL APPs"
- 2. Click on "FOLLETT DESTINY"
- 3. You should be logged in already. If not, you log in with the same info you log into your Chromebook.
- 4. Click on the top tab "MY INFO"
- 5. This will show you your current checkouts and fees/fines. A list of your current checkouts will appear first. Scroll down to see Fees and Fines.

Note: It will not show your Chromebook because that is checked out in a different system other than Destiny.
